REGISTRATION & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Registration from 0730 both days. AGB membership cards must be shown on request.
Equipment inspection will be carried out prior to start of practice.

AWARDS

Trophies/Medals will be awarded based on the number of archers competing in each category. Novice Archers may choose to shoot a shorter round but will not be eligible for awards. Archers shooting the WA 1440 (gents and ladies) are eligible for WA Star awards, Silver Star, English Cross and Hampshire Junior Awards are available for those archers shooting the relevant rounds. Junior Archers wishing to compete for the senior awards must enter as a senior archer and pay the senior fee. Parental signature still required.

ENTRY FEES

Seniors £16-00 per day, £28-00 for both days. Juniors £12-00 per day, £20-00 for both days.

EVENT TIMINGS

Assembly 0830 both days, followed by 45 minutes of practice. Rounds start at 0930

EVENT FORMAT

Both Days:- WA 1440 90m, 70m (gents & ladies) + Metrics I-V
Metric I - Boys under 18. **Metric II** - Boys under 16, girls under 18. **Metric III** - Boys under 14, girls under 16.
Metric IV - Boys under 12, girls under 14. **Metric V** - Girls under 12.
Please Note:- The two shorter rounds will be shot in ends of 6 arrows.
Compound & Recurve Archers shooting the 90m or 70m rounds will shoot on individual 6 ring faces at the 2 shorter distances. Barebow & Longbow Archers will shoot on full 80cm faces for both shorter distances.
All remaining metric distances will be shot on full faces throughout.

SHOOTING RULES & DRUG TESTING

This tournament will be shot to World Archery rules in force at the time of the event. Archers competing at World Record events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for their Junior Archers (under 18) to be tested if approached.

SMOKING

Would archers please note that smoking (including the use of e cigarettes) is only allowed behind the tents. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy.

REFRESHMENTS

A selection of hot & cold food and drinks will be available throughout the weekend.

PHOTOGRAPHY & DRESS CODE

In line with AGB Policy, those wishing to take photographs during the weekend must register with the tournament organiser. Unauthorised photography is not permitted. As this is a Record Status Shoot, AGB rule 307 regarding dress codes will apply.

CAMPING

Unfortunately, the land owners do not allow overnight camping on the site. However there are numerous camp sites located within the area.

PETS

Please note that only assistance dogs are allowed on the field.

CAR PARKING

Car parking will be available adjacent to the shooting field subject to the land owners permission.
