Registration & bow inspection	Registration from 8-00 am. Archery GB membership cards must be available and shown on request. Equipment inspection will be carried out prior to start of practice.
Awards	Trophies/medals will be awarded based on the number of archers competing in each category for the highest score. Junior archers wishing to compete for the senior awards must enter as a senior archer and pay the senior fee. Parental signature and date of birth are still required.
Entry Fees	£10-00 per session
Event Timings	First session assembly at 9-00 am, shooting to start shortly afterwards with 2 ends of practice. Second session to start at 12-00 pm and third session at 3-00 pm approx.
Event Format	<u>Portsmouth</u> - All Compound archers will shoot on a vertical 3 spot 60cm face All Recurve, Barebow & Longbow archers will shoot on a 60cm full face. <u>Worcester</u> - 16"Worcester face for all except compound archers who will shoot on a 5-ring compound face. 5 arrow ends. <u>WA18</u> - All Compound and Recurve archers will shoot on a vertical 3-spot 40cm face. Barebow & Longbow archers will shoot on a full 40cm face. All bosses will be layed foam (Tenzzone Targets)
Shooting Rules & Drug Testing	This tournament will be shot to World Archery Rules in force at the time of the event. Archers competing at record status events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply - non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents/guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for the junior archer (under 18 years) to be tested if approached.
Smoking	Smoking is not allowed anywhere inside the building. Please use the designated smoking area provided outside, including E-cigarettes. Entry to this tournament is considered acceptance of this policy.
Refreshments	Unfortunately there is no cafe at Gang Warily so please bring your own food. There will be facilities for tea/coffee.
Photography	In line with the Archery GB policy, those wishing to take photographs during the weekend must register with the tournament organiser. Unauthorised photography is not permitted
Dress Code	As this is a record status shoot, Archery GB rule 307 for dress codes will apply
Special Note	Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection.
Pets	Please note that only assistance dogs are allowed in the hall.
Car Parking	Free car parking is available at the venue.
