Registration & bow inspection	Registration from 8am. Archery GB membership cards must be available and shown on request. Equipment inspection will be carried out prior to start of practice.
Awards	Trophies / medals will be awarded based on the number of archers competing in each category for the highest score. Only the first score of WA18 will count towards awards. Junior Archers wishing to compete for the senior awards, must enter as a senior archer and pay the senior fee. Parental signature and D of B information are still required.
Entry Fees	£10.00 per session
Event Timings	First assembly 9am, shooting to start shortly after with 2 ends of practice, 2nd session to start at 12am & 3rd session at 3pm APPROX.
Event Format	Portsmouth - All Compound archers will shoot on a vertical 3-spot 60cm face. All Recurve, Longbow & Barebow archers will shoot on a 60cm full face (1st Session) WA 18m-All Recurve and Compound archers will shoot on a vertical 3-spot 40cm face Longbow & Barebow archers will shoot on a full 40cm face (2nd & 3rd Sessions) All bosses will be layered foam (Tenzzone Targets)
Shooting rules	This tournament will be shot to World Archery rules in force at the time of the event. Archers competing at record status events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry form giving consent for their junior archers (under 18) to be tested if approached.
