Registration	Registration from 9am. Archery GB membership cards must be available and shown on request.
Awards	Trophies / medals will be awarded based on the number of archers competing in each category. Seniors may shoot shorter rounds but will not be eligible for awards. Junior Archers wishing to compete for the senior awards, must enter as a senior archer and pay the senior fee. Parental signature and D of B information are still required.
Entry Fees	Seniors £8, Juniors £4
Event Timings	Assembly 10am, followed by 1 end of sighters
Event Format	Long Western 4 dozen at 80y followed by 4 dozen at 60y (Shorter distances available) 6 arrow ends to be shot in two details
Shooting rules	This tournament will be shot to Archery GB rules in force at the time of the event
Smoking	Would archers kindly note that smoking (including the use of E cigarettes) is only allowed behind the tents. Persistent offenders will be warned and may be excluded from the tournament. Entry to the tournament is considered as acceptance of this policy
Refreshments	A selection of cakes and drink will be available throughout the day
Photography	In line with the Archery GB policy, those wishing to take photographs during the weekend must register with the tournament organiser. Unauthorised photography is not permitted
Dress Code	Archery GB rule 307 for dress codes will apply
Camping	Unfortunately the land owners do not allow overnight camping on the field. However, there are numerous camp sites located within the area
