KIT INSPECTION	Each day from 08:00 at the Judges' tent
AWARDS	Medals will be awarded based on the number of entries in each category. Novice archers may choose to shoot a shorter round but will not be eligible for awards. Juniors wishing to compete for the senior award must enter as a senior. Parental signature is still required

TIMINGS	Assembly 08:30 each day, followed by up to 45 minutes of practice. Rounds to start at 09:30
FORMAT	Saturday: All Compound archers will shoot on individual 6 ring faces. All others on full size faces. Sunday: All distances will be shot to method 2 in ends of six arrows throughout. Compound & Recurve archers will shoot on individual 6 ring faces for the 2 shorter distances. Longbow, Barebow & all Metric round archers will shoot on full 80cm face
SHOOTING RULES	The tournament will be shot to the World Archery rules in place at the time of the event
DRUG TESTING	Archers competing at World Record Status events may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents/guardians must sign the box on the entry form giving consent for their junior archers (Under 18) to be tested if approached.
SMOKING	Smoking (including vaping & e-cigarettes) is only permitted behind the back line of tents and away from the catering facility. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy.
REFRESHMENTS	A selection of hot and cold food & drinks will be available throughout the weekend.
PHOTOGRAPHY	In line with AGB policy, those wishing to take photographs during the weekend must register with the Tournament Organiser.
DRESS CODE	Archery GB Rule 307 applies and will be enforced.
CAMPING	Limited overnight camping is available but must be requested from the Tournament Organiser prior to arrival. Please note: There are no facilities for chemical toilet emptying. These MUST NOT be emptied in the Portaloos under any circumstances.
ANIMALS	Other than the natural forest wildlife, only registered assistance dogs are permitted on the field and MUST remain behind the waiting line at all times.
